## 2020 SEASON UPDATES

This year's Farmers Market will be functioning as your "food chain supplier" and will not be focused on being a community gathering place due to COVID-19 restrictions. We are currently working with the Health Department Staff to remain up-to-date on State and Local Guidelines.

Visit our no-touch **TEMPERATURE CHECKING STATION** at the entrance, which will also have info on the market and a **HAND SANITIZING** area.

## CHANGES

- ☀ All Market Vendors, Staff and Volunteers will wear face coverings.
- ☀ The Market will have ONE entrance and exit on Central Avenue, at the center of Flanders Park.
- ☀ There will be 2 parking spaces denoted for **curbside pickup** off of Central Avenue at Flanders Park.
- ☀ All ready to-eat food & beverages (baked goods, food truck items, etc.) will be pre-wrapped or served in to-go containers.
- ☀ No sampling of products will be allowed.
- ☀ Booths will not be self-serve, please allow vendors to help you with your products.
- ☀ Vendors and Market Staff will clean high touch areas frequently.



## HOW YOU CAN HELP

- ☀ Please Wear a **Face Covering** over your nose and mouth.
- ☀ Please maintain a **6-foot distance** from others. Allow the person in front of you to finish their transaction and the vendor to sanitize their area if needed before approaching the booth.
- ☀ If you use **cloth bags**, we recommend that you wash them beforehand. Vendors will not be handling your reusable bags.
- ☀ Get contact info from vendors and **pre-order items** when possible.
- ☀ Make your visit as **brief** as you can.
- ☀ If you are experiencing any **sickness or symptoms** of COVID-19, including: fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills / repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell...please stay home and self-isolate.

## VENDOR GUIDANCE DURING COVID-19

This year's Farmers Market will be functioning as a "food chain supplier" and will not be focused on being a community gathering place due to COVID-19 restrictions. We are currently working with the Health Department Staff to remain up-to-date on State and Local Guidelines.

### Changes to the 2020 Farmers Market

- ☀ ALL Market Vendors, Staff, and Volunteers are required to wear **face coverings**, and must cover both the nose and mouth areas.
- ☀ The Market will have ONE entrance and exit on Central Avenue, at the center of Flanders Park.
- ☀ There will be 2 parking spaces denoted for **curbside pickup** off of Central Avenue at Flanders Park.
- ☀ Keep **10-feet** of spacing between vendor booths.
- ☀ The Dolores Chamber of Commerce will set up a **temperature booth** for vendors and customers to take their temperature using no-touch thermometers. A temp of 99°F must be monitored hourly, if your temp exceeds 100°+, then you must leave immediately and self-isolate.
- ☀ Keep customers **3 feet away** from your products, and gather items for them. You can utilize an empty table in front of your products, or rope off 3 feet in front of your table.

- ☀ **Disinfecting** solutions must be at every vendor booth, and all bottles must be labeled.

#### Disinfecting Solutions:

To make a bleach solution, mix 5 T (1/3rd cup) bleach per gallon of water, OR 4 tsp bleach per quart of water.

Alcohol solutions with at least 70% isopropyl alcohol may also be used.

Any commercial disinfecting product labeled to kill coronavirus can be used (wipes, sprays, hand sanitizer, etc)

- ☀ **Sanitize** hands after physical interaction with a customer, monetary exchange or any areas that a customer has touched before interacting with the next customer. An idea for no-touch cash handling is to use containers to collect and give out cash.
- ☀ **No sampling** of products allowed. All ready-to-eat foods must be served in to-go containers, or pre-packaged up.
- ☀ Do not handle customer's reusable bags.
